From doctor's appointments to prescription refills - all they need are the technology skills to navigate these virtual healthcare systems successfully. During the process of completing their dental master's education program back home in ` Ukraine, they decided to look into moving to America. Local residents Bob & Carol Bartles informed The Group of their prior dental training & interest to settle in Burlington, IA. With financial sponsors secured, they needed another community member to step in to assist with the many legal forms & procedures associated with the immigration process. The Group took this opportunity to grow the local dental professional workforce. While their international education doesn't translate to American practice standards, their prior experiences providing patients with dental care spoke for them. After submitting applications to CHC of SEIA & interviewing with the West Burlington dental clinic team, these two were recently offered dental assistant trainee positions & are excited to get back to work on local smiles in the clinic!! The Group has identified a local connection who is willing to assist the Lahun's along their pursuit towards aligning their international educational experiences with American practice standards.
